In the first two weeks of October we had two Honor Guard events plus an additional event supporting Life Chain activities on Respect Life Sunday. In 2009, over 1450 cities and towns held Life Chains (over 1700 locations). On Oct. 5th, we provided an Honor Guard for the St Faustina Feast Day Celebration at Church of the Nativity, and on Saturday Oct 9th we provided a Color Guard for opening ceremonies of the 19th annual St. Ann Special Athletes Fun Day at Christian Brothers High School. As the Patriotic Degree of the Order, we have a duty to honor those who have served our country and to help educate our next generation. Sir Knight's more than a title. It's an honor.

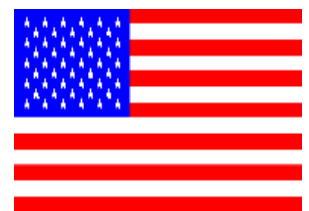
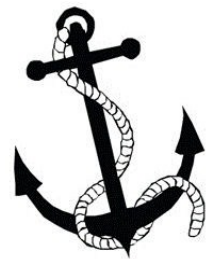
